
Sharing a meal brings people together, and our first 'At the Table' dinner is your chance to be part of that connection.

Our powerful sign brigade will once again line Springdale Street in Mount Horeb on Friday, February 6, 3:00 - 4:30 pm. We will meet at Liberty Park, 1201 Cox Drive. This action is driven by the recent murder of Alex Jeffrey Pretti, gunned down by ICE thugs in Minneapolis. It is driven by the countless acts of violence against "we the people" perpetrated by the Trump regime. It is driven by the lack of due process and acts of brutal barbarism. It is driven by the use of secret police, and by the inhumanity and immorality which have been brought to bear. We encourage folks to bring signs that memorialize Renee and Alex. # Meet The Author Mike McCabe


